MARLBOROUGH PINOT GRIS 2011

Here in Marlborough, classic Rapaura gravels absorb the sun's warmth during the day, radiating back onto the grapes by moonlight, to create the highly aromatic flavours for which Marlborough is so highly reputed.

OPAWA MARLBOROUGH PINOT GRIS 2011

This wine is pale straw in colour with a fragrant bouquet of pear and floral aromas with a hint of spice. The palate displays nashi pear and white peach flavours with a generous but soft, dry finish. Opawa Pinot Gris is a versatile food wine and matches well with a variety of dishes - especially lightly spiced Asian influenced cuisine.

VITICULTURE & WINEMAKING

Made from grapes sourced from both Wairau and Awatere Valley vineyards, the fruit was harvested in the cool of the morning and pressed using a long slow cycle. A cool tank fermentation followed, using an aromatic yeast. After a short period on yeast lees the wine was clarified and filtered prior bottling in June 2011
